Mr Akihiro Nishimura, Minister of the Environment, Japan, visited the JITMAP exhibition booth on 12 January. Dr Satoshi Kojima, Program Director of IGES Kansai Research Centre, provided the Minister with an outline of JITMAP and its activities. Others who visited the JITMAP booth during the exhibition included a range of companies, consulting firms, universities and research institutes, business organizations, supporting organizations, and NGOs from Japan and India. IGES and TERI representatives presented the JITMAP activities to the visitors and responded to their questions and inquiries. Participation in the exhibition helped raise awareness of JITMAP among stakeholders in India, and the interactions with participants also enabled gathering of information that could lead to future collaboration and development of our mutually beneficial activities.
